

SCTP 2010 SEASON

We would like to welcome everyone back for this years season of SCTP including those who may have had a year or so off. We are starting practices @ 10:00 am on Saturdays(except Feb 6th & Mar 6th due to range closure) and will move to Monday's @ 6:00 pm starting March 8. Depending on athletes schedules we may schedule a few different practice times this year to help keep things moving and create less down time for both parents and athletes. This can be something that is talked about as we create our squads. We are expecting to field squads in both trap and skeet so time management will be important.

Cost this year should be \$15.00 for TNSCTP and \$10.00 for VRPC if not already a member of the club. This will be due when signing up for team. Regional shoot should be in the \$20-25 range and the State shoot should be roughly the same. These fees will be due when we sign up for each event. By spreading the cost out it should be easier for everybody and create less confusion about what is paid for. If an athlete is shooting both trap and skeet, the shoot fees most likely will be doubled (not sure yet, but be prepared). As usual, rounds at the club will be \$2.00 and shells will run \$6.00 box. Feel free to supply your own shells for practice but for Regional and State shoots remember all boxes must be taxed stamped, and they do check them. We have applied for NRA grant money for targets and shells and should it come through this will possibly alleviate some of these cost later in the season (keep your fingers crossed). In addition should anyone have any fund raising ideas we would welcome any input.

Our schedule for the year is as follows.

Regional Trap Shoot May 1-2 @ Hog Heaven, White Pine

Regional Skeet Shoot May 8-9 @ VRPC

State Trap & Skeet June 3-6 @ Clarksville

There are also numerous ATA events in Morristown and Crossville should squads want to go. We ask that once you decide you want to participate with a squad you commit all the way through until at least the state shoot. Your team depends on you and should you not be there they can not compete as a squad. We have provided this years schedule with enough advance notice so plans can be made accordingly.

We look forward to a great year and hope to build off last years successes. As always we welcome any and all help parents can provide, score keeping, target moving, etc. In addition we are very limited in getting the word out in Knox County about SCTP, so any suggestions or ways to promote our program are also welcome.
